4. The URL, page, title, or other information identifying the allegedly infringing content on Gradiente Entertainment.
5. Your contact information, including:
 - o Email address
 - o Telephone number
 - o Mailing address, where applicable
6. A statement confirming that you are the copyright owner or are authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner.
7. A statement that the information provided in your complaint is accurate to the best of your knowledge.

Providing complete and accurate information will help us review your complaint more efficiently.

4. COPYRIGHT REVIEW & TAKEDOWN PROCESS

Upon receiving a sufficiently detailed copyright complaint, Gradiente Entertainment may:

1. Review the complaint and supporting documentation.
2. Contact the complainant if additional information or verification is required.
3. Identify and review the relevant content.
4. Contact the content provider or uploader where appropriate.
5. Take appropriate action where the complaint is substantiated, including restricting, disabling, or removing the relevant content.

Where ownership and infringement are sufficiently established, Gradiente Entertainment intends to take appropriate action within **7 working days from confirmation of the relevant information**, subject to the circumstances of the complaint and any applicable legal requirements.

The review period may vary where additional documentation, clarification, or verification is required.

5. CONTENT PROVIDER NOTIFICATION

Where appropriate, Gradiente Entertainment may notify the content provider, uploader, distributor, or other relevant party that a copyright complaint has been received concerning their content.

The content provider may be requested to provide evidence of ownership, licensing, authorization, or other relevant rights.

6. FALSE OR MISLEADING CLAIMS

Copyright complaints must be submitted in good faith and should contain accurate information.

Gradiente Entertainment reserves the right to reject or request clarification regarding complaints that are incomplete, unsupported, fraudulent, misleading, or otherwise insufficient to establish a legitimate copyright concern.
